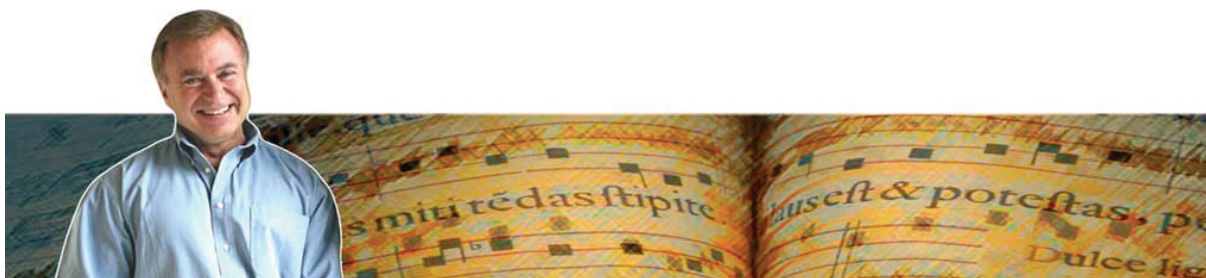


PREPARE THE WAY

SAMPLE SCHEDULE
